



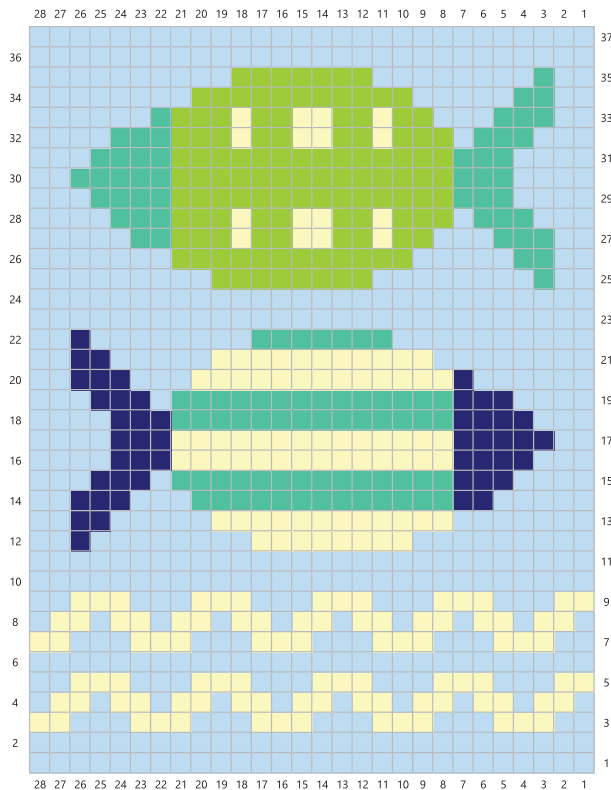
## Motif 9: Fish and Waves



Colourful fish and waves in a cotton-mix yarn make a summery square that can be combined with other coastal motifs.

- A** ■ Light Blue  
**B** ■ Cream  
**C** ■ Navy  
**D** ■ Turquoise  
**E** ■ Lime

**Yarn:** DK  
**Needles:** 4mm  
**Tension:** 22 sts × 28 rows over 4 × 4in (10 × 10cm) st st  
**Stitches:** stocking stitch, Fair Isle, intarsia, garter stitch, embroidery



**NOTE:** Work in Fair Isle for the waves section and intarsia for the fish section.

Using A, cast on 34 sts.  
 K 3 rows.

### Start chart

**Row 1 (RS):** K3, work row 1 of chart over next 28 sts, k3.  
**Row 2:** K3, work row 2 of chart over next 28 sts, k3.  
 Cont to 37 rows, keeping k3 at the beginning and end of each row.  
 K 3 rows.  
 Cast off.

### To finish

Sew in the ends. Block and press according to the yarn band instructions.  
 Using C, embroider a French knot on the top fish for the eye, then do the same on the lower fish using E.
